1. Please add some type of an arrangement on the welcome table. The sign is a table top sign 14inx18in free standing. It could have an arrangement on the top, or bottom or table.



2. Floral arrangement on 7foot gold hoop arch for seating chart and then for photos.



3. Two free standing hoop pillars behind the sweetheart tables. *5ft each



4. Just a few flowers for the cake.



5. A few flowers on the gold 3D Signs (2 signs say Cheers- at the bar & 3 signs say LOVE on tables)



6. Mr. and Mrs. Sign at the dessert table. (These are free standing but the photo is of them hanging)



7. Sign on easel in the back of the aisle: Brown Pick a seat either side... sign that is vertical. We would like the arrangement to be this type (not color). The top of the sign is 2 ft wide at the top. Can this then become the centerpiece at the sweetheart table? If not we would like something low for our sweetheart table centerpiece.



8. Can we please do the 2 stands grey with marble top arrangements AND the 2 larger arrangements on the ground and borrow your urns? We would like them in front at the gazebo and at the start of the aisle. What would your recommendation be on this? We wanted to add something for the aisle that would be brought into the reception so we didn't really want to use any décor on the chairs. Which size stand/arrangement would you put at the front of the aisle and what would you put at the back?
