

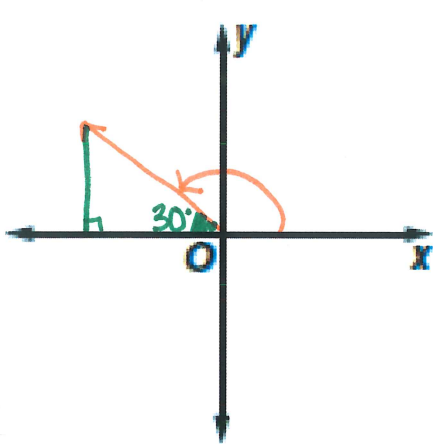

Reference Angles HW 2016-2017

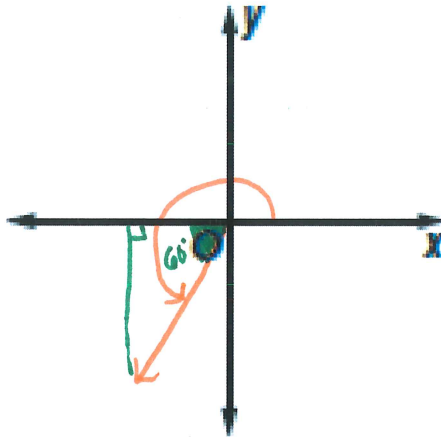
The **reference angle** is the acute angle formed by the terminal side of the angle and the x-axis. The reference angle is denoted by θ'

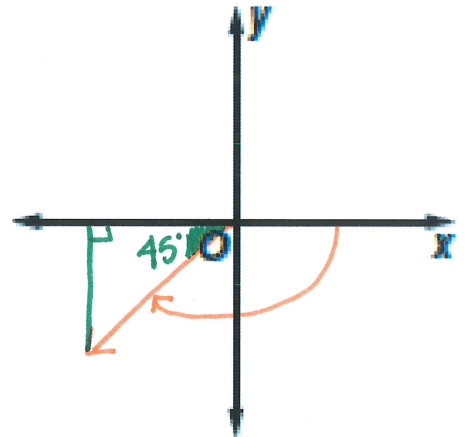

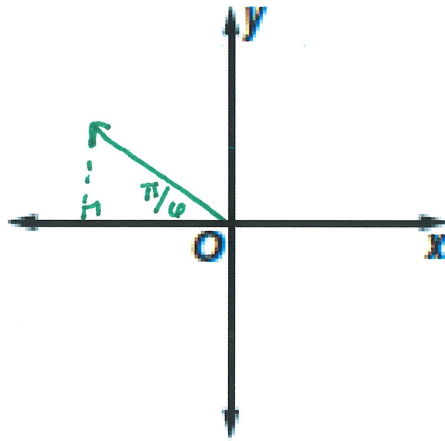

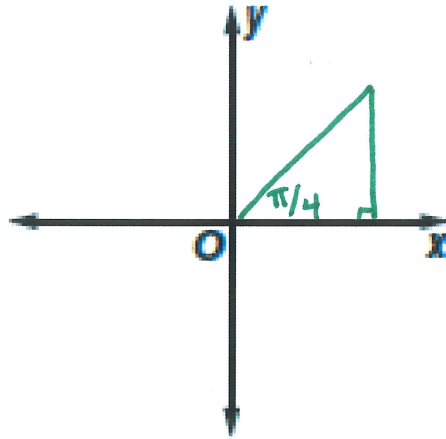
